
Principal's Update - April 22, 2024

Since our last meeting...

- The Bath Food Program continues to run strong thanks to our dedicated volunteers and the generous support of our community. We recently received donations from President's Choice Grant, two community groups, the Lionesses and the fire fighters association. In total, we have now received just over \$19 000 to put toward next year!!! A huge shout out to Mistene Clapp for her leadership in this area.
- The Scholastic Book Fair was a big success. Teachers will be using proceeds to buy books for the library and classrooms.

We have a few items that we are hopeful School Council will consider providing:

- 1. Ten Chromebooks for small student learning groups and for additional students or to replace as needed. The cost is \$373 per device x 10= \$3730

4.Track Ribbons

Dear School Council Members,

We are writing to request your support for our annual track and field event for students in grades 4-8. This day is not only fun, but an important part of our school's physical education program, promoting physical fitness and teaching valuable skills such as discipline, teamwork, and perseverance. Many students look forward to this day all year long.

To recognize our students' efforts and accomplishments on this day, we like to award ribbons for 1st through 6th place for each event. These ribbons serve as a tangible symbol of their hard work and dedication, fostering a sense of pride and motivation among our students.

As the cost of these ribbons has increased over the last few years we need your help to continue to provide them to students. We have looked at a variety of suppliers including local trophy stores and online retailers. Prices range from \$0.54 (Amazon)- \$1.50 (local supplier) per ribbon. As we need roughly 265 ribbons per year, Amazon seems to be the most economical option. We are requesting a purchase of 300 ribbons for \$162, however, as you can see on the attached image the price per ribbon decreases to about \$0.50 if we buy 600 ribbons which would be enough for 2 years.

Thank you for your time and consideration. Your contribution will directly benefit our students and enhance their overall experience in track and field.
